It's because the Village is implementing a 5-year tree-culling project to thin the ash tree population by 70-80% in an effort to curb the spread of the Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) that has infested trees in many cities, towns, and villages throughout the U.S. The Village, in partnership with the Lions Club, will work with local nurseries to replace the trees with new and varied species of shade trees based on a studied recommendation. As the project continues, there will be an opportunity for the public to dedicate and gift trees. Your input and involvement is encouraged.

Burnsite-Compost Site

Just a reminder, the burnsite-compost site **closes for the winter**. Through the month of October the following hours of operation apply:

First and Third Saturday mornings: 9am-Noon

Second and Fourth Wednesday afternoons: 4-6pm

The last days of operation before the site closes for the season: Saturday, November 4th & 11th

- Only leaves, grass clippings, and clean wood 6" in diameter or less will be accepted.
- Absolutely NO garbage, wood chips, stumps, old lumber, other wood products.
- Located at the end of Kopplin Rd E.

Weeds

Remember to keep weeds down around your property for safety and health reasons, and to eliminate invasive species.

Building Permits

A building permit is needed for new construction and renovations such as siding, roofing, decks, porches, fences, replacing doors and/or windows. Contact the Village Clerk's Office or check out the Village website.
