## Village News


The Clerk's Office, Police Department, Public Works and Village Board, along with their regular duties are working on:

## Winter Weather Reminder

### PARKING

Between Nov 1 & Apr 1, odd-even parking regulations shall be in effect between midnight and 6:00 a.m.  
On odd-numbered days, vehicles shall be parked on the side of the street with odd-numbered addresses.  
On even-numbered days, vehicles shall be parked on the side of the street with even-numbered addresses.

### SNOW SHOVELING

Snow must be removed from all sidewalks within 24 hours of end of snowfall.  
Snow shall not be blown into the street. Violators will be fined.

### SNOW REMOVAL BY VILLAGE

Use extra care when driving on streets that are being plowed or when the village crew is removing snow from the downtown area. Please slow down.
