The FC Historical Society is happy to announce that our Museum located at Randall Park in Fall Creek will be open to visitors on Sundays from 1pm-4pm through Sunday September 6 plus Labor Day. During this time of COVID-19 we do ask visitors to respect social distancing and our volunteer staff is making every effort to make your visit safe.

The Society has many resources to help people who are interested in researching their genealogy/family tree if you lived in the Fall Creek area. One that may be of particular interest is our scanned images of the original records of the Keller Funeral Home from 1931-1968.

The Society is working on loading information about the historical items that have been collected into a first-class museum software database called Past Perfect, which will allow us to easily retrieve information by person, subject, etc. This is a 12-18 month project. Gary Kunz has been hard at work scanning photos for our new database. We will be debuting a picture slide show on a large screen tv of some of our vast collection of photos at the museum.

WOOD BURN-COMPOST SITE

The Village maintains a wood burn-compost site that accepts clean, unpainted wood 6 inches in diameter or less, garden waste, leaves and grass clippings. Absolutely NO garbage, wood chips, stumps, old lumber or other wood products. The site is open:

April 1 through October 31:

1st & 3rd Saturday of each month from 9am-noon

2nd & 4th Wednesday of each month from 4-6pm

November: 1st two Saturdays from 9am-noon.
