

Chapter 15
Comprehensive Plan

[HISTORY: Adopted by the Village Board of the Village of Fall Creek on 9-10-2009.]

- A. In accord with § 66.1001(4), Wis. Stats., the Village having adopted written procedures to foster public participation in and for public meetings for which advance notice was provided in the matter of the adoption by the Village of a Comprehensive Plan in accord with § 66.1001, Wis. Stats., and the said procedures having been adhered to by the Village, the Village Board, upon recommendation of its Plan Commission, is in a position to adopt a Comprehensive Plan and the Plan Commission having further adopted a resolution upon majority vote of its entire membership, recommending to the Village Board that it adopt the instrument entitled “Village of Fall Creek, Eau Claire County, Wisconsin, Comprehensive Plan, 2009 – 2030,” which contains all of the elements specified in § 66.1001(2), Wis. Stats.
- B. The Village of Fall Creek held at least one (1) public hearing on its proposed Comprehensive Plan, all in accord with § 66.1001(4)(d), Wis. Stats., proof of which is on file with the Village Clerk.
- C. The said Comprehensive Plan does not take effect until the Village Board of the Village of Fall Creek adopts it by means of an ordinance.
- D. Pursuant to §§ 61.35, 62.23 and 66.1001, Wis. Stats., the Village of Fall Creek adopts the attached Exhibit “A” as the Village of Fall Creek Comprehensive Plan.
- E. This ordinance is adopted upon a majority vote of the entire membership of the Village of Fall Creek Village Board, in accord with § 66.1001(4)(c), Wis. Stats., as to which vote the Village Clerk shall attest in a certificate to be attached hereto as well as recorded in the official minutes of the Village Board.
- F. In accord with § 66.1001(4)(b), Wis. Stats., immediately upon its adoption, the Village Clerk shall send a copy of the attached Comprehensive Plan to each of the following: (1) the Clerk of the School District of Fall Creek; (2) the Clerk of the Town of Lincoln, Eau Claire County, Wisconsin; (3) the Wisconsin Land Council; (4) the State of Wisconsin Department of Administration; (5) the West Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission; and (6) the Fall Creek Public Library.
- D. That this ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publications as required by law.
