§ 114-1. Operation on Mill Pond. [Amended 8-9-2001]

- A. Except for the exclusion listed below, it shall be unlawful for any person or group of persons to operate a gasoline-powered motorboat on the Mill Pond located in the Village of Fall Creek without first obtaining special permission from the Village Board of the Village of Fall Creek.
- B. Permission is hereby granted to the Fall Creek Police Department, Fall Creek Area Fire District, Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and the Eau Claire County Sheriff's Department and emergency rescue personnel to operate gasoline-powered motorboats on the pond for the purpose of conducting emergency rescue. Training exercises shall be allowed for Fall Creek departments only.

§ 114-2. Violations and penalties.

Any person who shall violate the provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than \$25 and not more than \$50, plus court costs, and, in default of payment thereof, shall be confined in the county jail of Eau Claire County for a period not to exceed 10 days.
