§ 140-1. Adoption of statutory provisions.

The Village Board of the Village of Fall Creek hereby adopts W.S.A. s. 106.04 and all subsequent amendments thereto.

§ 140-2. Implementation.

The officials and employees of the Village of Fall Creek shall assist in the orderly prevention and removal of all discrimination in housing within the Village of Fall Creek by implementing the authority and enforcement procedures set forth in W.S.A. s. 106.04.

§ 140-3. Clerk-Treasurer to maintain forms and assist with complaints.

The Municipal Clerk-Treasurer shall maintain forms for complaints to be filed under W.S.A. s. 106.04 and shall assist any person alleging a violation thereof in the Village of Fall Creek to file a complaint thereunder with the Wisconsin Department of Industry, Labor and Job Development for enforcement of W.S.A. s. 106.04.
