Chairman Goodman opened the public hearing at 6:32 p.m. He explained that the present fees for the above listed items do not cover the cost of the required newspaper publication and notification to property owners, and in the case of a certified survey map, the engineer's review incurred by the Village. The amendment would increase the fee from \$75 to \$150 for a variance, a conditional use, and a rezone, and increase the fee from \$10 to \$150 + 100% of the engineer's review costs for a certified survey map. Chairman Goodman closed the public hearing as there was no public comment.
