Joe Sanfelippo: wants to keep the pond and area available for all the educational opportunities it provides.

Andrew Martin: should never give up an area that provides so much, including its natural beauty.

John & Michelle Kuehn: want to save the great view of nature it provides.

Curt Van Auken: should do what is necessary to clean up the pond.

Randy & Brandon Wathke: want to save the pond's value at a reasonable cost.

Richard Ziemann: preservation of this valuable & historic feature is a great plan.

Tim Raap: want to save the fishing & boating opportunities.
