- A. Consider Security Cameras at Municipal Properties: Chairperson Kaatz noted the committee has been working on this item, and it was tabled from the 7/11/2022 Regular Board Meeting to get more information. Administrator/Public Works Director Jared McKee received a several quotes totaling \$12,000 that included installation and cameras for the Village Hall and Keller Park. Additional expenses for live-feed security units would include installation by an electrician, a computer with internet access, a monthly internet fee of \$100, and at Keller Park a temperature-controlled area to house it. Committee discussed number of incidents at the park, locking the restroom doors when the park closes, sharing equipment with the Village Hall during the winter months when Keller Park is closed, live-feed versus closed-loop units, and the cost of \$100/month for internet access. Administrator/Public Works Director McKee suggested installing a trail camera. The issue could be revisited in the spring.
